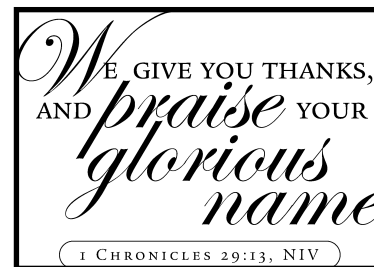



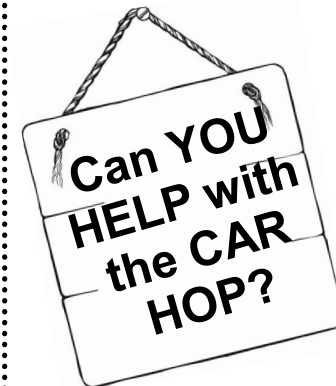
WELL DONE, KIDS!! Keep putting the notes in the box in Pastor Dirk's office. Each month we draw a note from the box.
