

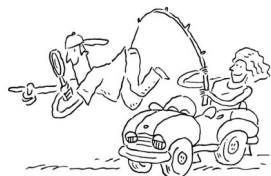

TREASURE HUNT!

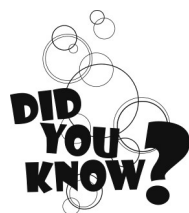
Children who are in 4th grade or older may go on the hunt with a parent.

Youth Group kids —please bring 2 lbs. of BBQ, and plan on helping to clean up! This is a great way to earn more money for your account!!

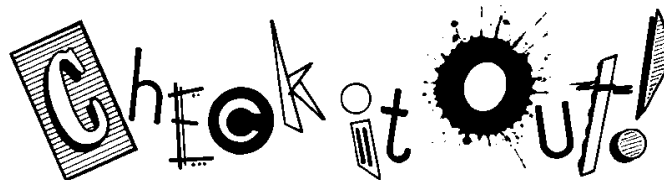


Congregation—Are you willing to help with childcare for the evening? PLEASE let a leader know!!

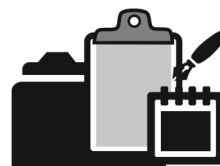

Council Notes

- Carl and Chris Dick are willing to sell their home and property (3.46 acres) to Prosper Church for a negotiated price of \$255,000. The church can commit up to \$100,000 now. The additional \$155,000 will need to be raised no later than February 28, 2020. The Council is requesting congregational approval for this purchase at a special **October 27** meeting after the morning service.
- The process for new Elders and Deacons is in progress. Council asks the congregation for continued prayers.
- The annual Congregational Meeting will be held on Sunday, December 1 after the morning service. This will include Elder/Deacon drawing and voting on the 2020 budget.
- Quarterly water sample for bacteria is good.
- 3rd Quarter Denomination and Classical Ministry Shares have been paid in full.
- The parsonage roof has been repaired.
- The Building Committee is seeking bids for a replacement of the Fellowship Room carpeting.
- Council would like to remind you that any who arrive late to a worship service, to please wait until the call to worship and prayer have been completed and then be seated during the congregation greeting or singing. Thank you.
- Council recommends the congregation to read the books that the church is providing! There are copies of *Pray Big* by Alistair Begg, and *The Gospel Comes with a House Key* by Rosaira Butterfield. You will find them on the table in the Fellowship Room.
- Council recognizes that former member and a child of the congregation Abby DeZeeuw (Ebels), has completed her seminary requirements and accepted a call to serve as a Hospice Chaplain through Spectrum Health. She is being ordained today, Oct 13.
