

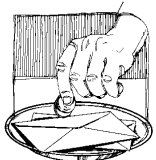


...from March 2, 2020 meeting

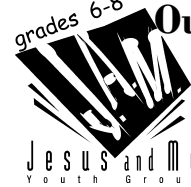
