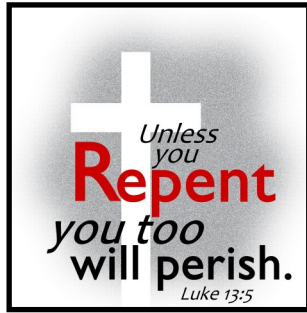


Prosper Christian Reformed Church!

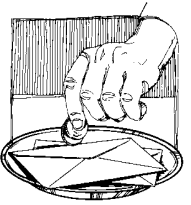
